USGA Rules in Effect Except Where Modified by Local Rules

Men: If your ball lies within the white posts, you may take free relief from where your ball lies, or where your ball struck the fence. If you take free relief, you must lift, clean, and place your golf ball no nearer to the hole within the boundary determined by the white line. This rule is only for holes #3 and #7.

On holes #9 and #13 if you wish to take relief from the fence you may bring the ball back as far as you want and lift, clean, and place your golf ball no nearer to the hole.

The area between the fencing on Woolworth is deemed Ground Under Repair. If your ball comes to rest between the fence you must take relief no nearer to the hole. If your ball goes through the fencing and can't be found you may take relief under no penalty if your entire group comes to agreement that the ball has rolled down Woolworth Street.

Women: On holes #3 and #7 once the ball has passed the markers at the end of the fairway it may be placed behind the markers on the other side of the road and played from there. On holes #9 and #13 the ball must strike the fence before you may place it across the street.

All yardage markers measured to the center of the green.

Fences bordering the golf course are considered out of bounds.

Balls striking the split rail fence or light poles on Woolworth Ave. are to be replayed from original spot.

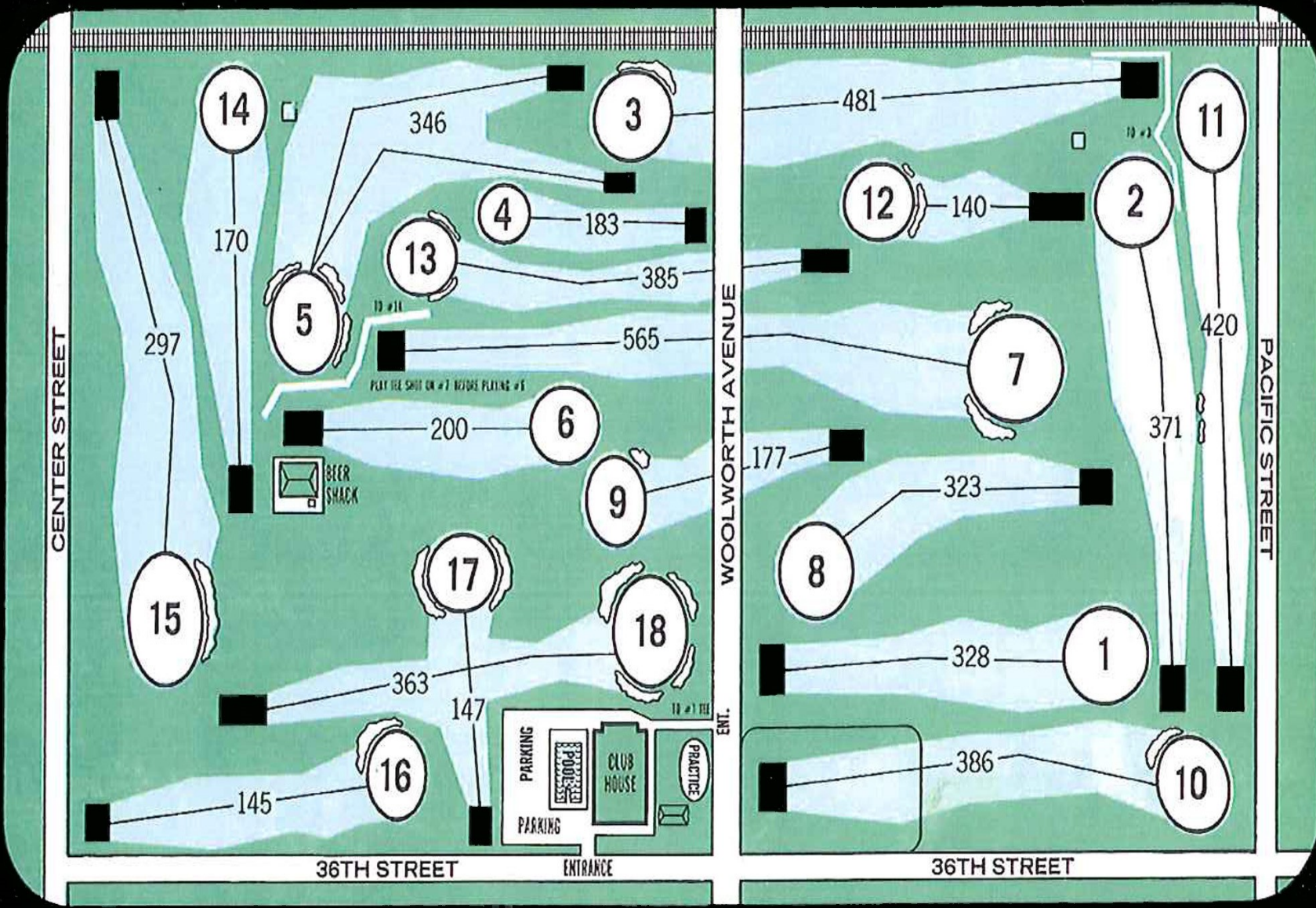
